Arbury Court

Our Services

Arbury Court, situated near Warrington, is home to our purpose built, medium and low secure services. Partnerships in Care (PiC) has extensively redeveloped the site to provide a modern and spacious environment, providing person centred treatment and care for men and women with mental illness and/or personality disorder.

The unit consists of a specifically designed unit with two 15-bedded wards for men with a diagnosis of mental disorder who are detained under the Mental Health Act 1983. The women's service is purpose built and consists of 44 beds divided into four wards of varying security; including medium and low secure services.

Environment

Attention has been paid to greater allocation of physical space and access

areas. Each patient has an individual bedroom with en-suite facilities.

Location

Arbury Court is located at Winwick, Cheshire, with easy access to the M6 and M62. It is one of three of our hospitals in the North West. The others are The Spinney, outside Manchester and Kemple View in the Ribble Valley, Lancashire.

Treatment and Care Pathway

We provide care and treatment in differing levels of security, to promote the development of care pathways and a positive patient experience. The experienced multi-disciplinary team work collaboratively with patients through an individualised care pathway.

We offer individual treatment programmes including violence and sexual offending work, substance misuse and fire setting. The clinical team, through a stress vulnerability model, are able to support the patient to understand and manage their mental health symptoms including: insight awareness, relapse prevention and compliance therapy.

Rehabilitation and the principles of recovery dictate that care is 'person-centred' as opposed to 'disease-centred'. A bio-psychosocial model, that incorporates positive psychology and psychosocial interventions along with evidence based pharmacological treatment, will be integral to the treatment provided in this service.

PiC National Training Centre

The site is also home to the PiC National Training Centre which allows us to provide a suitable venue for sharing best practice and ongoing training and development of staff. The training centre is also available for external agencies.
