Low Secure Services for Men in the North West



Our Services

Kemple View has been developed to cater for patients whose needs can best be met in a low security environment. We offer services to men suffering from mental illness or personality disorders.

Our expert care helps people with severe and enduring mental health problems to progress and maximise their quality of life.

- **Mental illness services** offer specialised assessment, treatment and care for men whose needs cannot be met in mainstream services
- **Personality disorder services** are provided in an environment where the emotional distress suffered can be both understood and alleviated
- **Rehabilitation and continuing care services** are available on a slow track basis with an emphasis on quality of life. Following clinical interventions and comprehensive risk assessments many of our patients have unescorted leave within the hospital grounds. Such patients are often encouraged to access community facilities with the help of nurses and occupational therapists, and this is a significant part of their treatment.

Location

Kemple View is set in the Ribble Valley in Lancashire, with beautiful views over the valley and surrounding countryside, coupled with excellent public transport to the city of Preston.

Treatment Programmes

Every patient's journey begins with a comprehensive and detailed assessment that provides a clear understanding of their abilities, needs and risks.

Care is provided by our multidisciplinary teams of specialist clinical staff, including psychiatrists and psychiatric nurses, psychologists, social workers and occupational therapists. Our highly skilled clinicians deliver a variety of treatment programmes to groups or individual therapy, including:

- Life Minus Violence (award winning programme for violent offenders)
- Sexual Behaviour Management Programme
- Problem Solving Skills Training
- Substance Misuse Services
- Emotional Regulation Programme
- Mental Health Awareness Programme
- Group Work Skills
- Motivational Groupwork Programme.

Recreational Facilities

Facilities include a large occupational therapy horticultural area, a gym, education room, art and woodwork workshops and extensive therapy rooms. We recognise the optimum environment is one with the least possible restriction and most appropriate support.
