Howell Ward at Llanarth Court Hospital is a service for men with complex mental health needs, aimed primarily at those with mental illness and high functioning autism.

We offer an innovative service with a holistic approach aimed at the treatment and rehabilitation of patients using evidence based therapies.

Facilities

The hospital is set in 80 acres of beautifully kept grounds with educational, occupational and sporting facilities including a gymnasium and a swimming pool.

Howell ward is purpose built with 17 individual bedrooms and has a range of common rooms. We have access to a therapy area that is currently utilised for art, computer and craft sessions. There is a large dining room and an Occupational Therapy kitchen, where the patients can prepare meals. We also have a visitors' room.

Patients have access to a secure garden and, with the relevant pass, can access the beautiful grounds and lakeside areas.



Howell Ward has an intensive care suite that is self contained with its own bedroom, lounge and toilet.

Our Multidisciplinary Team

We have a high staff patient ratio including forensic consultant psychiatrist, nurses, clinical psychologists, art psychotherapists, sports therapists, education tutors, social workers, activity coordinator and occupational therapist.

Individual and group therapies promote the patients' awareness, understanding and management of their own mental health problems.

Service aims and objectives

- To meet the needs of men with complex mental health problems, and challenging behaviours
- Innovative programmes and evidence based treatments that are tailored to the needs of individual patients
- To work with the men to address the issues underlying their difficulties in a way which is positive, engaging and meaningful to the patient

- To promote an effective risk assessment framework
- To engage and regularly liaise with each patient's community team, family, carers, and funding commissioners. (Invitations to CPA's).

Admission criteria

- Men over 18
- Detained under the mental health act 1983
- Men with mental illness and/or autistic spectrum disorders complicated by substance misuse, offending behaviour, or other co-morbid conditions.
